

What is a hurricane?

Unlike some emergencies, we know when a hurricane is coming. This gives us time to get ready.










We may have to cover windows, bring furniture inside or visit a friend or family member for a short time.







When the hurricane comes the sky will turn dark and it will begin to get windy and rain.
